### **GENERAL ACCOUNTABILITY**

The Aircraft Painter is responsible for the preparation, marking and painting of aircraft and components. This includes both company and customer owned aircraft.

### **SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITY**

Aircraft cleaning and stripping

- Clean aircraft, parts and components
- Strip surface of aircraft, parts and components
- Remove stripper with squeegees and pressure washer

Aircraft and aircraft parts prepping

- Orbital and hand sanding
- Scotch-brite scrubbing
- Masking of aircraft and hangar
- Complete etch and alodine process
- Tacking aircraft skin
- Polishing aluminum
- Advanced Paint design layout

Aircraft painting

- Shake paint and keep paint bucket full
- Spray paint
- Clean paint guns and other paint units
- Touch-up
- Parts priming and painting

Safety

- Demonstrates safe work practices and techniques

Other

- Mask and clean hangar floor
  - Prepare and maintain a clean work area
  - Complete Transport Canada paperwork
  - Operate lift equipment
  - May teach and mentor Paint Preppers
  - Other duties as assigned by Paint Shift Lead
